Darwin's first high-rise launched

The 28-storey *Pandanus* building, designed by leading architecture and design firm Woodhead, is the first of its kind in Australia for a building of its height to be cyclone-resilient, while catering for a tropical climate suitable for a Darwin lifestyle.

The building offers a dynamic blend of residential and serviced apartments, luxurious penthouses, restaurants, retail space and a day spa.

Serviced apartments within the complex are to be managed by leading hotel operator Mantra Hotel Group. Each apartment has its own balcony that overlooks Darwin city or harbour, and emphasises larger living spaces.

Woodhead Regional Principal Keith Savage, said, "The building design respects climate, capitalises on the views and provides the perfect setting to enjoy Darwin. The design intent is to provide spacious balconies and open-living space which are excellent for entertaining and a modern lifestyle."

The complex is close to the shopping precinct of Darwin and to the entertainment area of Mitchell Street, as well as the new Wharf Precinct.

Pandanas sets a new standard in resort style living and is designed to be an urban sanctuary.
